Composition Book Instructions

This will be where you keep all of your notes and answers to reflective questions on the readings you are assigned. This is also where you will keep your “bell work” that is assigned daily in class. The front and back of your comp book need to have your name and period.

Front of book “Reading Notes”

The first page of your comp book needs to be labeled as “Reading Notes.” Each entry should begin at the top of the page and that page should be labeled with the date of the assignment, and title of the assignment (e.g. reading title and author or name of practice test)

This is where you will answer the assignment reflective questions and add any of your own notes on the reading. **Underneath your answers and notes should be a box with vocabulary words that are new to you, including the definition and part of speech, and the sentence that includes the word.**

Back of book “Bell Work”

(Flip book over and have page #1 be the last page of the book)

The first page of this section should be labeled as “Bell Work.” Include date of the assignment above the assignment. This is where you keep any “bell work” that is on the board when you walk into class. It will include such assignments as bell quotes, syntax practice, and reflections.

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
