

SUCCESSFUL LIBERTY MATH STUDENTS:

- **Come to class prepared every day (pencil, book, notebook, binder, etc.)**
- **Are on time every day (in their seat when the bell rings working on their warm-up)**
- **Take complete notes every day in class and do all “You Trys” (class work) provided**
- **Are quiet, attentive and FOCUSED on the activities during class time**
- **Do their homework every night completely (yes, there is homework every night)**
- **Show all of their work on their homework, quizzes, and tests**
- **Come in for extra help if they aren’t understanding something**
- **Study for all tests and quizzes (read over notes, do practice problems, complete study guides and/or toolkits, work out odd problems in the book and check the answers in the back, etc.). Quizzes occur once or twice during every chapter. Tests occur at the end of each chapter (usually every two to three weeks).**
- **Do not have any electronics out or on during class time (no phone, I-pod, etc.)**
- **Know their multiplication tables (knowing how to handle decimals and fractions is VERY beneficial)**
